CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

Vinyl Pinnacle Woodgrains and Colors are low maintenance, but may become dirty during handling or exposure to atmospheric conditions like any other product.

Regular Care and Maintenance

Clean as needed with a damp, soft cloth. If necessary, a mild detergent or soap can be used. Do not use organic solvents, paint thinners, polishing compounds, nail polish remover or abrasive cleaners. Pesticides and herbicides or chemicals with U.V. inhibitors may cause discoloration. Clean surface immediately. Always use clean, soft cloths, no metal brushes or abrasive sponges.

Removing Marks or Stains

If the laminate is stained or marked by a foreign substance, and water or mild soap does not remove the issue, the following can be tried:

- Cleaning wipes such as Clorox® or Lysol® brand. Type with textured cloths is more effective.
- Mild cleaners such as Simple Green®.
- Mild stain remover such as Goo Gone®. Do not use solvent-based cleaners such as Goof Off®.

Always test cleaners in a small, inconspicuous area. After cleaning laminate, rinse with clean water. Follow all manufacturer instructions and warnings on label. Aggressive cleaners are used at your own risk and potential damage not covered by warranty.
